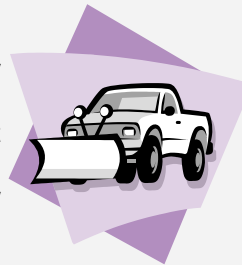

### Snow Season Considerations

It is time once again to take into consideration parking on the streets during a snowfall. Please keep your cars in the driveway so the streets can be cleared properly. (Heavy snows typically require a second plowing.) Do not pile the snow back into the street. **During a snow emergency, cars parked in the streets will be fined**



**\$100 per incident; cars parked overnight will be towed.** Remember that a snow emergency refers to the entire city. Also, please help us save money by keeping the stakes installed by the snowplow contractor in place. Many have been knocked down by children. If your stakes are down and there is damage to your lawn, the snow removal company will not be held responsible. Please be aware and park safely!

### Property Modifications

Co-owners are reminded that any exterior modification to their home or property may require approval by the association board. All modifications must be approved and done by a licensed insured contractor.
