# By-law Rules for Property Modifications

All modifications must be approved in advance and done by a licensed & insured contractor if required. This includes, for example, fences, pools, decks, sheds, roofs, windows, slabs etc. CHECK FIRST!

EFFECTIVE 1/1/2023 the board of directors has added a \$35.00 administrative fee for any modification form submitted <u>after</u> the work has begun.

## Snow Season Reminders

It is time once again to take into consideration parking on the streets during a snowfall.
